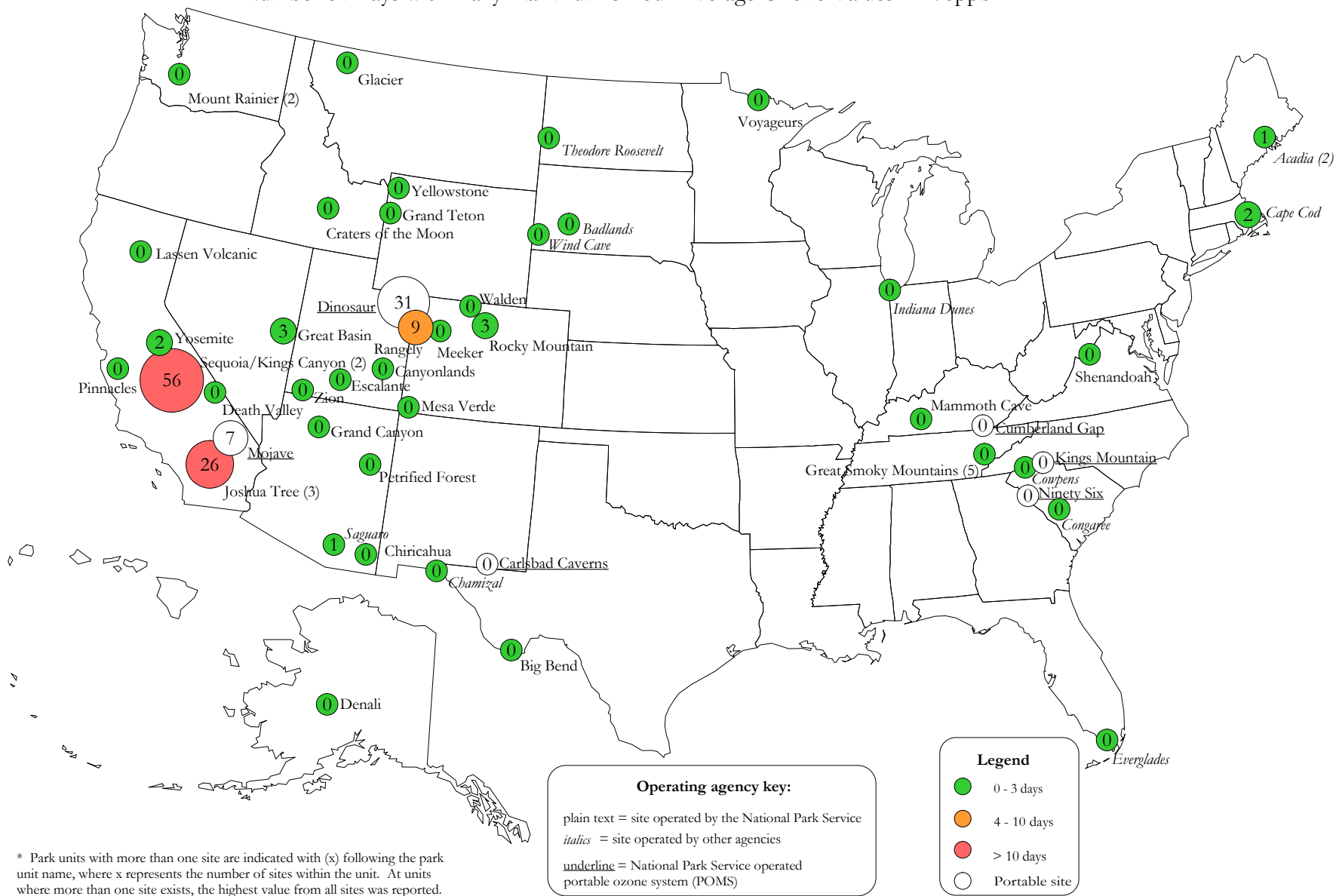

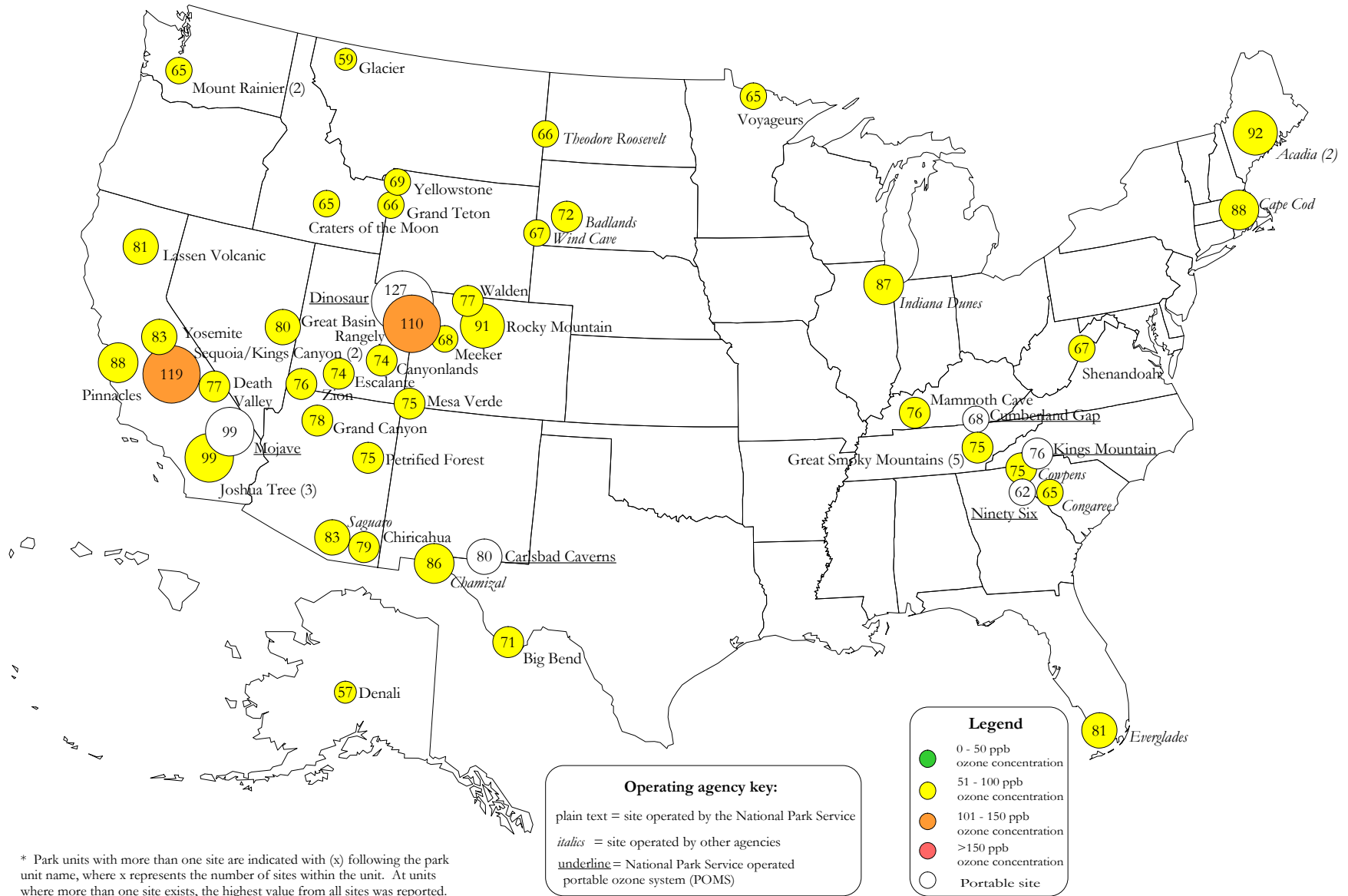

Number of Days with Daily Maximum 8-hour Average Ozone Values ≥ 76 ppb



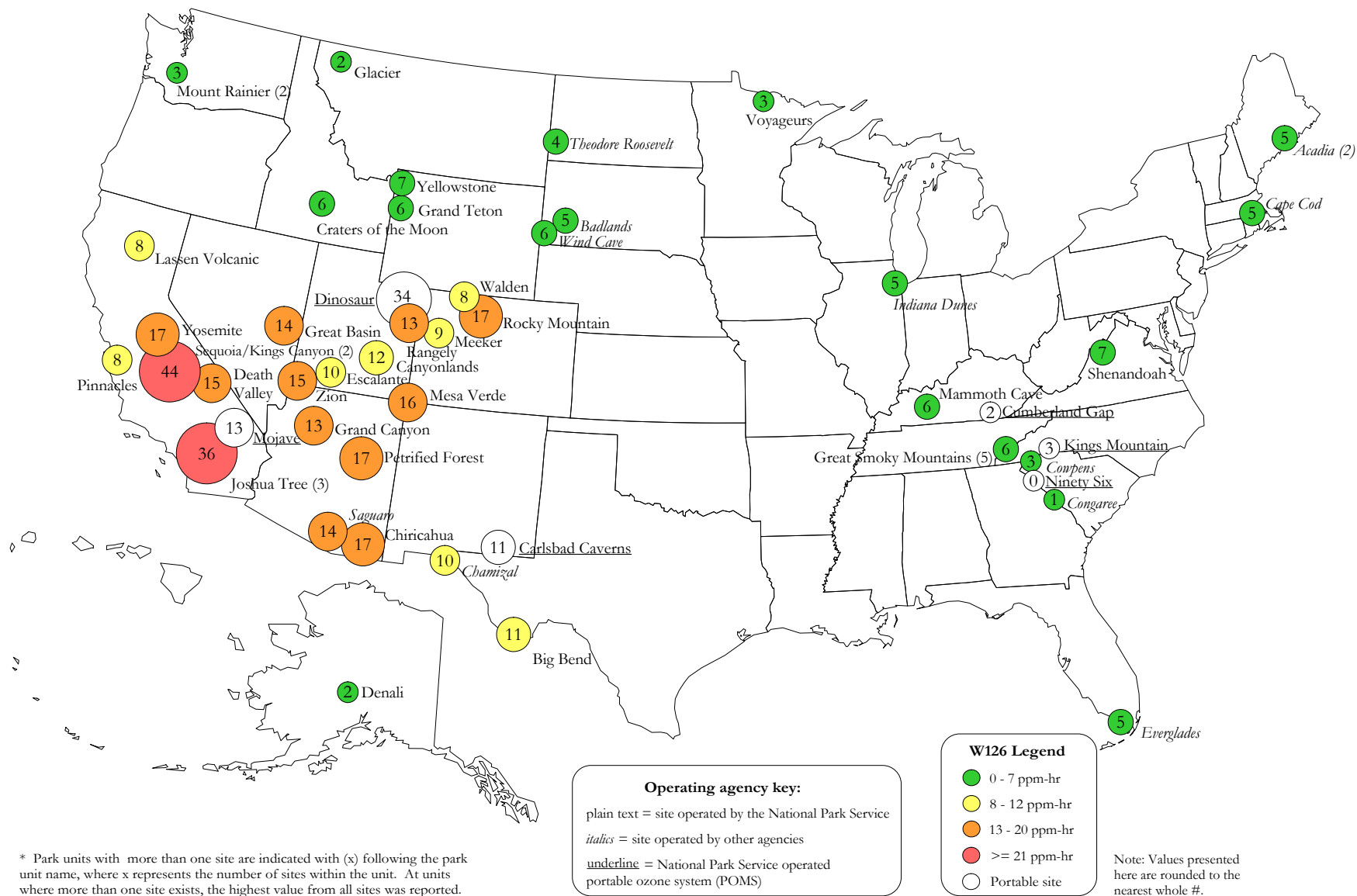

Annual Second Highest 1-Hour Average Ozone Concentrations (in ppb)



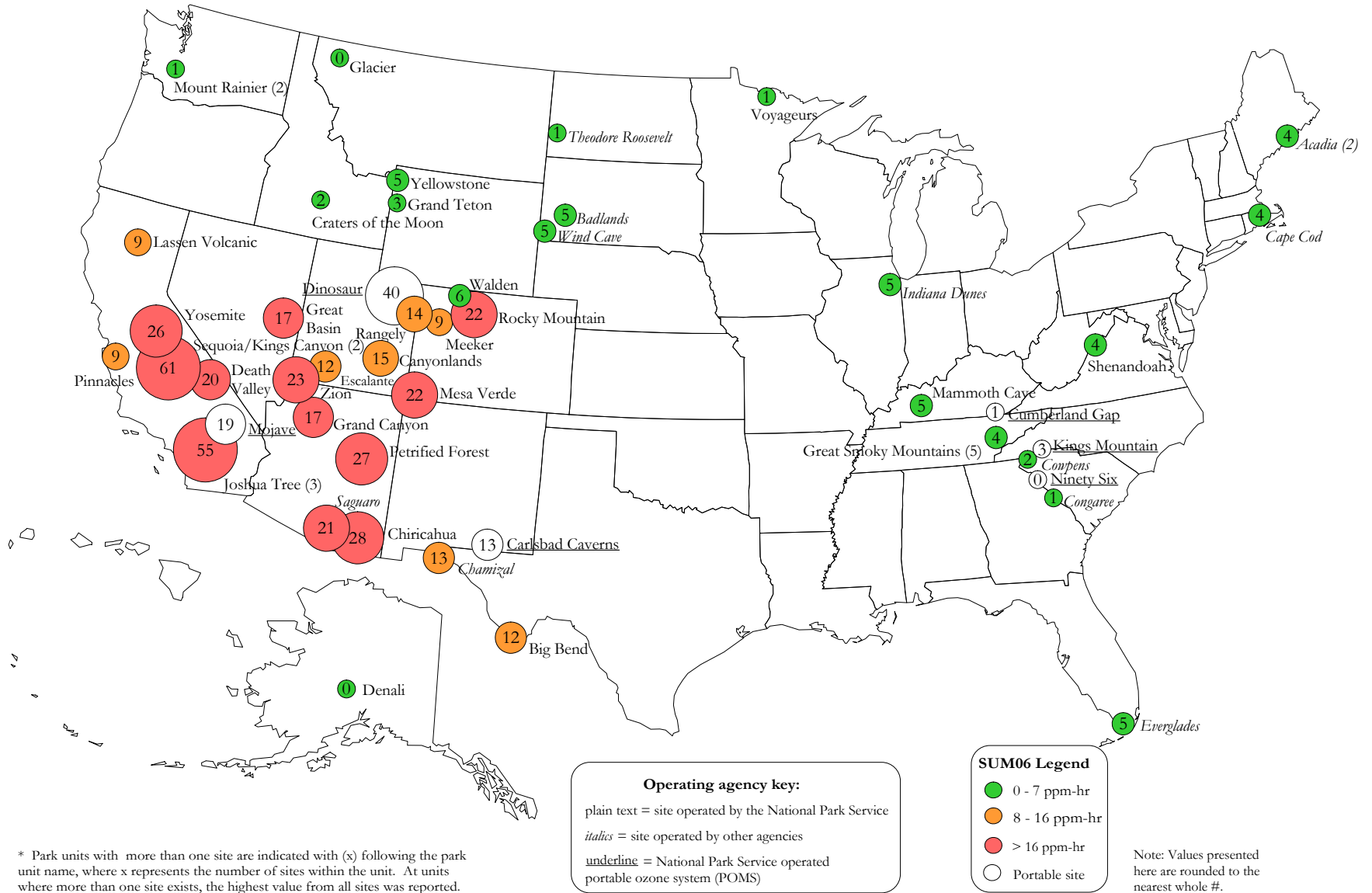
